The Main Stage event will combine **all** performers (professionals, students and directors).

#2 - <u>Individual musicians</u> in grades 7th through college level, are invited to perform in the **Music in the Park Orchestra (MITPO)**, which is not your traditional band/orchestra set up. Students can expect to learn and perform exciting and "funky" music that will incorporate various genres. Our guest conductor will be **Maestro Miguel Atwood-Ferguson** from Los Angeles, California. You must register by

Students must be committed to attending 3 rehearsals leading up to the big day. The rehearsal dates and location will be announced at a later time.
